WHY MMMCERP?

This is an opportunity to build off of the mandate of the Million Man March, to build and maintain our community together, to make the problems of our brothers and sisters our problems, and to solve them together. The MMMCERP is a way to galvanizing our community's creativity, spirit and entrepreneurial talents (UJIMA/COLLECTIVE WORK AND RESPONSIBILITY)

HOW WILL MMMCERP WORK?

MMMCERP's initial goal is to create a continuous circulation of black dollars within the Black community. **Within the first 90 days, we seek to sign-up a minimum 1000 auto-ship customers to purchase common household goods manufactured and distributed by Black owned manufacturers.** Auto-ship is an easy method which allows a customer to sign up and on a monthly basis receive their chosen allotment of products and product variations (such as bathroom tissue, paper towels, soap, laundry detergent, toothpaste, and trashcan liners (most products Black Manufactured). This small base of auto-ship customers will provide the start to constructing the foundation to produce 100 new jobs within one year. **Monthly reporting of the progress will take place on the Ertha Harris Tight Knit Radio Show on Radio One WOLB 1010 AM.** (UJAMMA/COOPERATIVE ECONOMICS)
